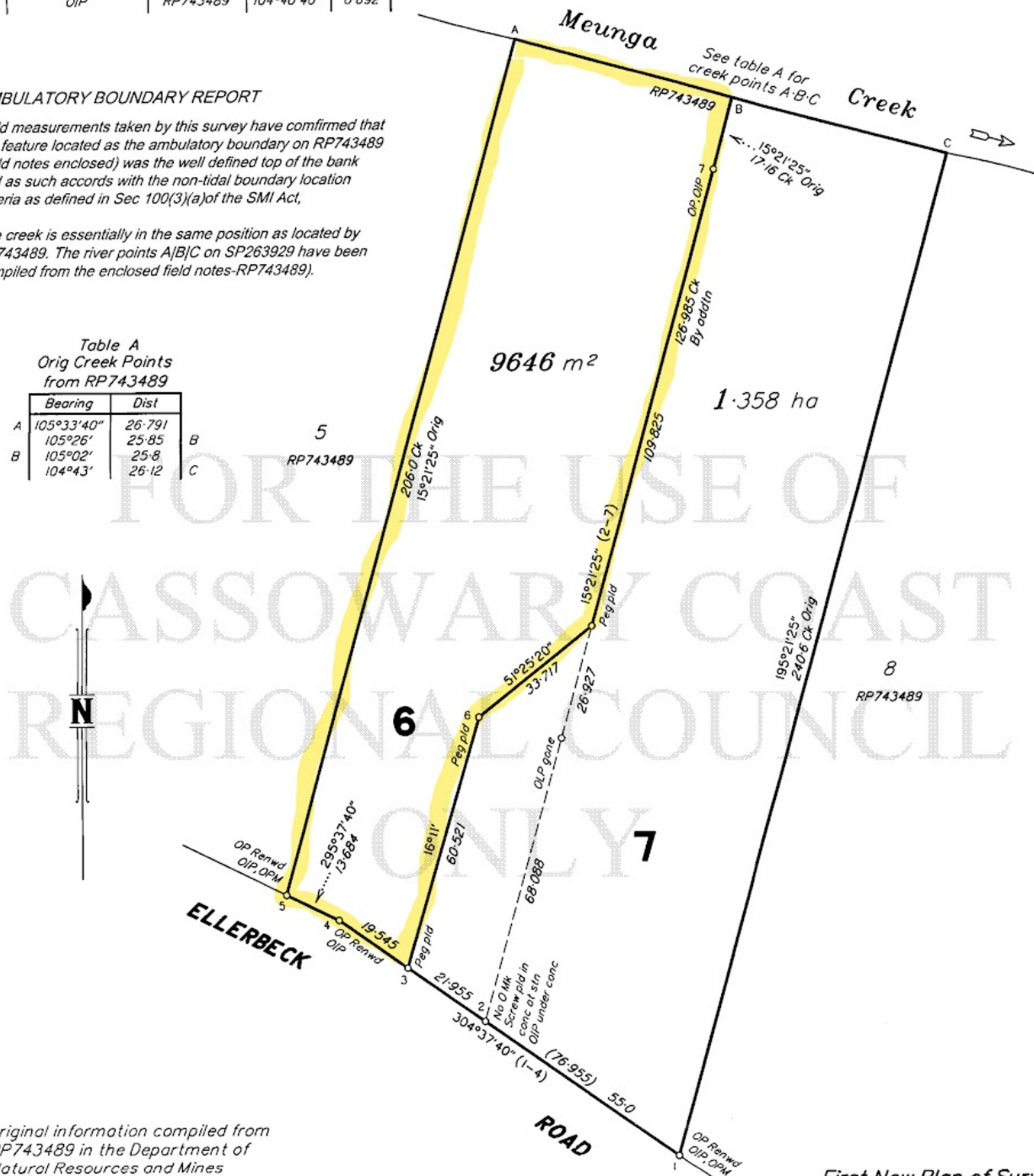
AMBULATORY BOUNDARY REPORT

Field measurements taken by this survey have confirmed that the feature located as the ambulatory boundary on RP743489 (field notes enclosed) was the well defined top of the bank and as such accords with the non-tidal boundary location criteria as defined in Sec 100(3)(a) of the SMI Act.

The creek is essentially in the same position as located by RP743489. The river points A|B|C on SP263929 have been compiled from the enclosed field notes-RP743489).
