You're not the one who has to wonder where they are, because you already know they're out there, being kids, on land that's actually big enough to get lost in for an afternoon.

Or maybe that season's already been and gone for you, and what you're after now is room to breathe instead: a flower garden worth pottering in, a vege garden and glasshouse to grow your own produce, a spare bedroom for when the grandkids stay over, and a peace that's entirely yours.

Inside, the house holds that same sense of space. Past the tiled entrance, the kitchen, dining and living area opens up, and your eye goes straight to the windows at the far end, where the rear section and hills beyond sit framed like it was built for exactly this. It's the moment people actually say it out loud: what a spot. The kitchen itself has been properly thought through - enough cupboards, drawers and bench space that everything has a place, made for actual cooking.

A sliding door leads through to the lounge, where a pellet fire waits for the nights that call for one, and both living spaces spill out onto a covered verandah - the kind of place where you lose track of time, coffee in hand, with nothing to listen to but whoever's next to you and the birdsong. There's a third, more intimate living room tucked off the lounge too.
